Prestart checklist

- A strong internet connection Ideally, you will need to be on Wi-fi or have good 4G signal.
- ✓ An eSIM compatible device If you are unsure, see list of compatible devices here
- ✓ Your device must not be locked to a single network.
- ✓ Update your iOS to the latest version.

New Click-to-Install feature

- You can now install your eSIM by clicking the link you received in your email. This makes life so easy!
- Minimum iOS 17.4 required.


eSIM name

- During installation, Apple assign a random name to your eSIM.
- In this guide we assume Apple labelled your new eSIM 'Business'. It could be called 'Travel', 'Mobile Data', 'Personal' or 'Secondary'.
- Tip: Your Primary SIM will have your mobile number underneath.






- When installation is complete, you will notice 2 signal strengths at the top of your screen!

Tips

- The signal strength shown on top is the one being used for "Mobile Data".
- To save battery, turn off your new eSIM if you're not using it.
- We suggest you name your eSIM "easySim" so you can easily recognise it. To do this:
- Goto Settings > Mobile Service > "Secondary" > "Business" > enter "easySim" in CUSTOM LABEL
